



## FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Fun ways to host fundraising events in your school and community!

- **Birthday Club:** If you have ever thought of helping others on your birthday, we have just the activity for you. This year instead of collecting birthday presents, why not ask everyone to make a donation to Children's of Alabama?
- **Lemonade Stand:** You can host your very own Miracle Makers Lemonade Stand.
- **Yard Sale:** Consider having a yard sale to support Children's of Alabama. You can get the whole family and even neighbors involved to participate.
- **Penny Wars:** Set a goal, have a collection box in the classroom, and have the students bring in their spare change for a day or even a week.
- **Caps for a Cause:** Pick a day, and let the students pay \$1.00 - \$5.00 to wear their favorite hat to school.
- **Bake Sale:** You can have your church group, neighbors, school or community group do a bake sale.
- **Bicycle Races:** For those who love to ride bikes, have a bike race and spin for kids.
- **Flag Football Tournament:** Gather some football enthusiasts and have a flag football tournament.
- **A-Thons:** You can have a dance marathon, bowl-a-thon, walk-a-thon, hop-a-thon, or create one of your own. Participants register and ask for sponsors to pledge money.
